1.	Preliminary discussions about the development of a new certifying course (CAS, DAS, MAS) in continuing education	D - X	
2.	<ul> <li>New course design proposal by the Program Director in collaboration with the FCUE including the following elements:</li> <li>Planning a Continuing Education Course: Key Questions</li> <li>Estimated budget</li> <li>Retroplanning</li> <li>Endorsement from the Faculty/Faculties involved (UNIL or EPFL)</li> <li>The FCUE provides the required documents and supports the Program Director.</li> </ul>	D -18 months	
3.	Development and validation of the following elements by the FCUE:  Program, study plan, assessment, number of ECTS credits Study regulations Budget and self-financing threshold Communication plan	D -12 months	
5.	Development and validation of the brochure	D – 10 months	
4.	Study regulation approval by the Faculty and University management (UNIL or EPFL)	D -10 months	
6.	Promotion launch, registrations open (according to the FCUE promotional calendar)	D -9 months	
7.	Registrations close, candidates are selected and final decision on launch of the course is made (if the min. number of participants for self-financing is reached, the course can launch)	D – ca. 4 months	
8.	Start of the course	D Day	
9.	End of the course	End of course + 3 months
